Day 3 – Colombo – Sigiriya (Approx. 5 hrs)

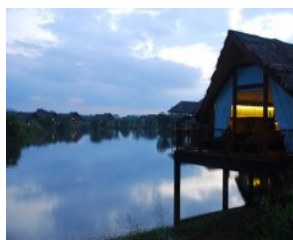

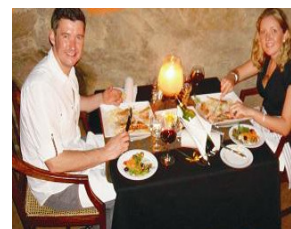

Day 5

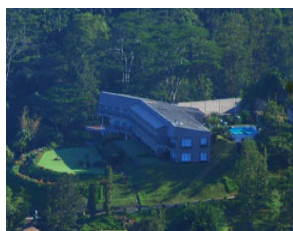

In the night, you will be having a private dinner outside the property at a carefully selected location surrounded by beautiful sceneries.

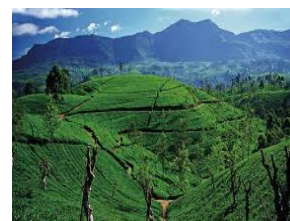
